Commitment to work schedule

We follow federal, state, and local guidelines to help ensure the safety of our staff, volunteers and guests. If a volunteer is scheduled to work but is sick, injured or for any other reason they should notify management in a timely manner so that a replacement can be found to fill in.

Volunteers should not come to work with flu symptoms, diarrhea, vomiting, sore throat, fever, or any other potentially contagious illness.

Conduct

You are expected to conduct yourself according to Biblical standards. Treat all people with respect. Refrain from gossiping or using inappropriate language. All prices marked on items in the coffeehouse and the resale store are suggested donation amounts. Do not question or complain about marked prices in front of customers. If you have a comment on pricing, or if an item isn't marked talk to a manager privately.

Volunteer Meal Policy

Volunteers who work a shift may have drinks, snacks or any leftover food in the refrigerator or freezer for free. This does not include food that has been prepared for upcoming events. Complementary food and drinks are to be consumed on the premises and not taken home.
